Campers are required to wear hard-soled shoes with a heel, long pants and a helmet when mounted. Helmets will be provided or they may bring their own SEI/ASTM approved helmet. Gloves are optional. Campers may change to shorts after riding.

Each camper should bring a lunch and snack, and plenty of liquids; a water cooler is available throughout the day. Food and drinks may be kept cold in the camp refrigerator; a microwave is available to heat lunches

There are five 2012 sessions:

- I. June 11 - 15
- II. June 18 - 22
- III. June 25 - 29
- IV. July 9 - 13
- V. July 16 - 20

Campers may attend multiple sessions. **Space is limited** to 8 campers per week. Additional week(s) may be added if demand warrants.

One session may be designated an advanced camp. An evaluation lesson (\$35) is required *before* registration. Students must demonstrate ability to trot and canter. Instruction will include jumping. Classroom topics will include riding theory and equine science.

Cost for the week is \$315, or \$299 for siblings. Register by May 1st to receive a 10% discount.

To secure reservations, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 must accompany this form.
